MOSCOW TELNO 778 (NOT TO ALL): GORBACHEY'S LETTER TO REAGAN

1. AT THE COUNCIL'S WEEKLY LUNCH LEDOGAR (US) READ OUT A REPORT ON DUBLINARY'S MEETING WITH PRESIDENT REAGAN ON 23 JUNE.

BEGINS

- -- SOVET AMBASSADOR DUBINEN CALLED ON THE PRESEDENT ON JUNE 23 TO PRESENT HOS CREDENTHALS. DURING THE COURSE OF THE MEETING, DUBINEN PRESENTED A LETTER FROM GENERAL SECRETARY GORBACHEV TO THE PRESEDENT.
- -- THE MEETING WAS CORDINAL. POSITIVE AND FORWARD-LOOKING.
- THE PRESIDENT RECALLED THAT THE TWO LEADERS HAD AGREED THAT A SUMMENT SHOULD BE HELD IN 1986. HE WELCOMED RECENT SOVIET PROPOSALS AT THE NUCLEAR AND SPACE TALKS IN GENEVA, AS WELL AS RECENT SOVIET STEPS TO RESOLVE A NUMBER OF HUMANISTARIAN CASES.
- -- DUBLININ, IN HIS REMARKS, AFFIRMED GORBACHEV'S DESIRE FOR A SUBSTANTIVE OUTCOME AT THE SUMMENT, AND SAID GORBACHEV BELIEVED THAT GOOD ARMS CONTROL AGREEMENTS WERE WAITHIN REACH. HE SAID GORBACHEV ALSO WAS INTERESTED IN MAKING PROGRESS ON REGIONAL AND BILLATERAL INSSUES.
- -- THE MANN THEMES OF GORBACHEV'S LETTER, AND DUBININ'S REMARKS, WERE:
- -- THE SOVIETS ARE AS DISAPPOINTED AS WE BY DEVELOPMENTS AFTER GENEVA, AND HAVE ADVANCED A COMPREHENSIVE SET OF ARMS CONTROL PROPOSALS WHICH HAVE NOT RESULTED IN RECIPROCAL MOVEMENT BY THE U.S.
- -- MOSCOW US CONVENCED THAT WITHOUT SOME ASSURANCE THAT ACTUAL AGREEMENTS WILL BE REACHED, THERE WOULD BE NO POINT IN HOLDING A SUMMER.
- THE U.S. AND SOVET UNION SHOULD ENTENSIFY DISCUSSIONS ON THREE
 AREAS FOR AGREEMENT: SPACE AND STRATEGIC OFFENSIVE WEAPONS SEME
 COLON MAF SEME COLON AND NUCLEAR TESTING.

- GORBACHEV ALSO CHIED THE POSSIBALITY FOR PROGRESS IN SUCH AREAS AS CONVENTIONAL FORCES, NUCLEAR REACTOR SAFETY, PEACEFUL USES OF OUTER SPACE, AND BHLATERAL CONTACTS.

- THE SOVIETS BELIEVE THAT THE WAY TO PROCEED NOW IS TO FOCUS EFFORTS IN ONGOING NEGOTHATILONS AND EXPERT LEVEL DISCUSSIONS, AND TO MALINTAIN CONTACT THROUGH EMBASSIES. THESE EFFORTS COULD BE REVIEWED AT THE FOREIGN MINISTER LEVEL AT A TIME YET TO BE DETERMINED. ENDS

2. LEDOGAR SAIND THAT PRESS REPORTS THAT THE LETTER HAD CONTAINED NEW PROPOSALS FOR AN EQUAL GLOBAL LIMIT ON INF WERE INACCURATE, ALTHOUGH GORBACHEY HAD UNDICATED A READINESS TO CONSIDER SOME, UNDEFINED, HATERIM AND PARTHAL MEASURES. IN SHORT, THE SOVIET UNION HAD NOT DEMONSTRATED ANY NEW WILLINGNESS TO ACCEPT EQUAL GLOBAL LEVELS ON IMF.
