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

SHULTZ/ SHEVARDNADZE: NATO PRIEFING PY SHULTZ

1. THE SOVIET UNION HAD NOT COME TO VIENNA READY TO MAKE SEPICUS
PROGRESS AFTER REYKJAVIK. MUCH THAT HAD BEEN SPENT ON DISPUTING THE
REYKJAVIK RECORD, NOTAPLY OVER THE ELIMMINATION OF HUCLEAR
WEAPONS/BALLISTIC MISSILES BY 1996. BUT SOME PROGRESS ON HUMAN
RIGHTS INSSUES, AND HE WAS PREPAPED TO PE PATIENT.

2. MR RENTON ATTENDED THE BRIEFING WHICH SHULTZ GAVE TO NATO FOREIGN MINISTERS FOR AN HOUR YESTERDAY EVENING, OF HIS TALKS WITH SHEVARDNADZE ON 5 NOVEMBER (THEEE HOURS) AND 6 NOVEMBER (TWO HOURS). SHULTZ OPENED BY SAYING THAT HE COULD NOT REPORT ANYTHING LIKE THE KIND OF PROGRESS THE UNITED STATES WOULD LIKE TO HAVE SEEN. THE US HAD BROUGHT TO VIENNA ITS DUDTE FIRST TEAM UNQUOTE, READY TO CARRY FORWARD THE VISSUES DISCUSSED AT REYKJAVIM, BUT THE SOVIET STOE WAS EVIDENTLY NOT READY TO RESPOND. THE DISCUSSIONS ON HUMAN RICHTS, AND BILATERAL AND REGIONAL VISSUES HAD NEVERTHELESS BEEN SATUSFACTORY, AND HE WAS READY TO BE PATHENT. ON THE DISCUSSIONS ON POORPAMME OF COMMON ACTIVALTY WORKED OUT AT REYKJAVIK, AGREEMENT HAD BEEN REACHED ON JOINT ACTIVALTY IN THE CIVALITAN SPACE SECTOR, AND THE SOVMET UNION HAD PRODUCED PROPOSALS FOR WORV ON TRANSPORTATION AND ENERGY.

ARMS CONTROL

3. ON ARMS CONTROL THE SOVIET SIDE HAD COME TO VIENNA APPARENTLY DETERMINED TO CHOTE PICK A FIGHT UNDUSTE OVER WHAT HAD TENTATIVELY EEEN ACHIEVED AT REYKJAVIK, AND NOTAFLY OVER WHAT HAD BEEN AGREED AS POSSIBLE IN THE NUCLEAR STRATEGIC FIELD. THEY HAD SOUGHT TO COMPRESS EVERYTHING THE PRESIDENT HAD SAID AT REYKJAVIK HINTO AN OPLIGATION TO ELIMINATE NUCLEAR WEAPONS BY 1996. IN ADDITION, THE SOVIET UNION HAD HINSISTED ON CONCENTRATING DISCUSSION ON THE ARM TREATY, WHERE THEY APPEARED TO WISH TO PUT ALL POSSIBLE WEIGHT ON CONFIDENCE FESEARCH ON STRATEGIC DEFENCE TO THE LABORATORY, WHATEVER THAT MEANT. THERE WERE SOME ANDICATIONS THAT THE SOVIET UNION PIGHT NOW ATTEMPT TO APQUE

STRATEGIC DEFENCE TO THE LABORATORY, WHATEVER THAT MEANT. THERE WERE SOME ANDICATIONS THAT THE SOVIET UNION MIGHT NOW ATTEMPT TO ARGUE THAT LAPORATORIES COULD EXIST IN SPACE, FOR EXAMPLE, AS WELL AS IN A RESEARCH WASTITUTE. THE POSITION OF THE UNITED STATES WAS THAT THE TERMS OF THE ABM TREATY SHOULD CONTAINUE TO APPLY AND TO BE OBSERVED. THERE WAS NO SIGN THAT THE SOVIET UNION WAS READY AT PRESENT FOR THE KIND OF DIALOGUE THAT WOULD BE NEEDED TO MAKE PROGRESS ON SDI. 4. DISCUSSION ON CONTROL OF STRATEGIC WEAPONS HAD CENTRED ON THE QUESTIONS OF WHETHER THE SECOND FIVE YEAR STAGE OF DISAPMAMENT SHOULD APPLY TO ALL NUCLEAR WEAPONS OR TO BALLISTIC MISSILES ONLY, AND THE OBLIGATIONS TO APPLY TO THE ABM TREATY AFTER TEN-YEAR EXTENSION. THE SOVIET UNION HAD SOUGHT TO DISTORT THE RECORD, AND MUCH THEE HAD BEEN SPENT OVER THIS. KAMPLEMANN COMMENTED THAT THE SOVIET UNION HAD SAID THAT HIT WANTED TO QUOTE STRENGTHEN UNDUOTE THE ABM TREATY, BUT THIS 4N EFFECT AMOUNTED TO SEEKING AMENDMENTS. SHULTZ SAID THAT SHEVARDNADZE HAD NEVER BROUGHT UP THE MISSUE OF LINKAGE, HOWEVER, DESPITE THE IMPPESSMON THE SOVIET UNION HAD BEEN SEEKING TO GIVE TO THE PRESS SINCE REYKJAYTK. MUCH WOULD NOW DEPEND ON THE ATT-TUDE OF THE SOWIET UNION AT THE REGOTALATIONS WHICH WERE NOW TO RESUME AT GENEVA. THE SOVIET SADE HAD UNDERTAKEN TO TAPLE THERE PROPOSALS WHICH WOULD PROBABLY EMEDDY HTS VERSION OF WHAT HAD FEEN AGREED AT REYKJAVIK. MEANWHILE, WORK WAS ALSO CONTINUING ON THE POSSIBLE ESTABLASHMENT OF NUCLEAR MASKS CENTRES. MA THE CONVENTIONAL SPHERE, HE HAD EMPHASISED TO SHEVARDNADZE THE AMPORTANCE OF MAKING PROGRESS BOTH ON CW AND ON CONVENTIONAL FORCE REDUCTIONS, NOT LEAST BECAUSE OF THEMR RELEVANCE TO NUCLEAR DISARMAMENT, AND HAD SAID THAT CONCRETE DEDISHONS BY THE ALLIANCE ON THE FUTURE OF CONVENTIONAL ARMS NECOTIFATIONS MUST FIRST AWAIT THE CONCLUSTON OF THE WORK SET IN HAND AT HALAFAX. THIS APPLIED ALSO TO THE SOVIET SUGGESTION OF WORKING GROUPS ON CONVENTIONAL ARMS REDUCTIONS.

5. MR RENTON ASKED SHULTZ TO COMMENT ON THE SOVIET POSITION ON THE ELIMINATION OF ALL NUCLEAR WEAPONS BY 1996. WAS HT SERTOUS, OR ONLY TACTACAL? SHULTZ SAID HE DID NOT THINK COMPLETE ELIMINATION WAS POSSIBLE BY 1996. INT WAS ALWAYS NECESSARY TO BEAR IN MIND THAT PEACE CONTINUED TO DEPEND ON NUCLEAR DETERRENCE, AND THAT TO THE EXTENT THAT PROGRESS HAD BEEN MADE ON AGREEING ON REDUCTIONS HAN NUCLEAR WEAPONS THIS WAS BECAUSE THE ALLHANCE POSSESSED AN IMPORTANT CAPABILITY. ROS RIEGVAY ADDED THAT THE SOVIET SIDE HAD PROPOSED THAT BEFORE THE END OF THE 10 YEAR PERIOD AGREEMENT SHOULD PE REACHED ON HOW TO ACHIEVE COMPLETE ELIMINATION, AND A DATE SET FOR THAT. 4T WAS AMPOSSIBLE TO SET SUCH DATES NOW. PROGRESS WOULD FARST BE NEEDED ON A SCUNDER CONVENTIONAL BALANCE, THE ELIMINATION OF CHEMICAL WEAPONS, AND A BETTER UNTERNATIONAL CLIMATE. SHULTZ COMMENTED THAT THIS SHOWED WHERE THE QUOTE NEGOTHATHING SPACE UNCUSTE LAY, HE EVER THE DIALOGUE GOT SER-LOUS. WE MUST BE PATHENT. TERRORISM

6. SHULTZ SAID THAT HE HAD TOLD SHEVARDNADZE THAT HE WAS
DISAPPOINTED THAT THE SOVIET UNION SHOULD DISMISS THE DAMNING
EVIDENCE OF SYMMAN INVOLVEMENT IN MATERNATIONAL TERROPHSM WHICH HAD
BEEN UNCOVERED BY THE PRITISH SYSTEM OF JUSTICE, TO WHICH HE PAYD
WARM TRIBUTE. MAYEST GATHON OF THE KARACHI AMBPORT AND DENT WAS
ALSO PRODUCING UNCREASING EVIDENCE OF LITTYAN MAYOLVEMENT.
SHEVARDNADZE'S RESPONSE HAD NOT FEEN SATISFACTORY.

E. IN ANSWER TO A OWNESTION, SHULTZ SAID THAT THIS HAD NOT REEN RAISED. FOR WHATEVER REASON, GORBACHEV WAS CLEARLY RELUCTANT TO COME TO THE UNITED STATES AT THE PRESENT TIME.

9. SHULTZ SAND THAT HE KNEW SOVIET GOVERNMENT CLEARLY HAD A DIFFERENT APPROACH FROM ITS PREDECESSORS. WE MUST EXPECT IT TO BE MORE AGGRESSIVE AND LEGALISTIC IN ATTACKING THE HUMAN PIGHTS PERFORMANCE OF THE WEST. BUT PROGRESS WAS ALSO BEHHC MADE. THE SOVIET UNION HOW ACCEPTED THE STANDING OF THE WEST TO PAISE HUMAN RIGHTS CASES IN THE SOULET UNION. PROPOSALS FIRST RAISED AT REYKJANIK PROVISING FOR ONGOING CONTACTS ON HUMAN RIGHTS AND HUMANITARIAN HISSUES, HAD PEEN CONFIRMED ON VIENNA. THE SOVIET UNION HAD RESPISTED THE SETTING UP OF A HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION, BUT THERE WOULD NOW BE A BILATERAL REVIEW COMMISSION MEETING REGULARLY, PERHAPS QUARTERLY. THIS WOULD COVER ALL THE RELEVANT ELEMENTS. THE COMMISSION WOULD BE BILATERAL, PUT HE HOPED ALL OTHER ALLHANCE COUNTRIES WOULD ALSO CONTINUE TO PRESS THE SOVIET UMOK. 10 SHEVARDNAPZE'S PROPOSAL FOR A HUMAN RIGHTS CONFERENCE IN MOSCOW SHOULD BE NOT DASMISSED AUTOMATACALLY. BUT WE SHOULD ASK OF NOK GOVERNMENTAL ORGANISATIONS WOULD ALSO BE FREE TO BE THERE, WHETHER DISSIDENTS WOULD BE ALLOWED TO BE PRESENT IN MOSCOW, AND HOW FREE THE SOMET MEDIA WOULD BE TO COVER THE PROCEEDINGS. HE COULD NOT BELHEVE THE SOVIET UNION WOULD PERMIT AN OPEN MEETING, BUT THEY SHOULD BE BROUGHT UP AGAINST THE PROPLEM THEY HAD CREATED FOR THEMSELVES. KAMPELMANN ADDED THAT IT WAS SAGMIFICANT THAT THE SOVIET UNION WAS NOW ADOPTING WESTERN TERMINOLOGY. IT WAS DOING THIS TO TRY TO DEFUSCATE THE PROFLEM, BUT WE MUST USE AT TO FORCE THEM DOWN THE ROAD OF ADAPTING THEIR PRACTICE TO WESTERN STANDARDS.

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
