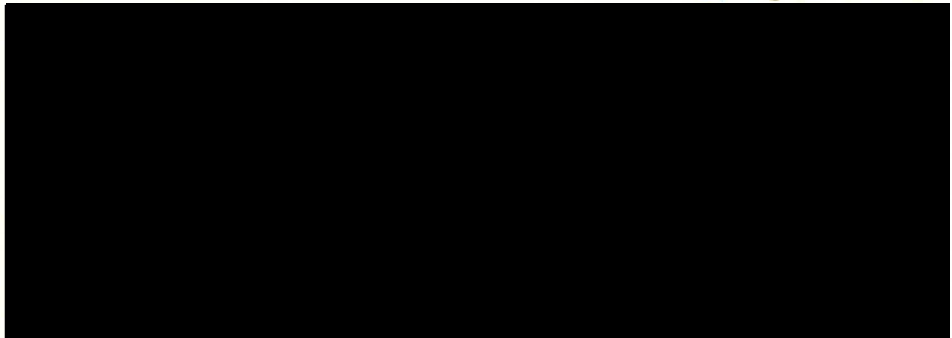
The Prime Minister has asked me to thank you for your very kind note and for sending in your pocket money to help pay for the petrol for the Prime Minister's Campaign Coach.
