Paradoxically, the more the Spanish had pressed him, the more he was inclined to believe that the Spaniards were not seriously interested in an early solution which might bring problems over Ceuta and Melilla. [Mr Bullard has expressed doubts about this analysis.] The Spaniards had said that they would not apply for NATO membership until September.
