Visit of the President of Korea

The Korean Ambassador has now informed us that President Chun, who will be making a European tour in the spring, proposes to pay a visit to Britain between 8-10 April inclusive. The visit would be in response to the invitation extended by the Prime Minister to the President in 1982 to visit Britain as a Guest of Government.

Would these dates be convenient to the Prime Minister? The Koreans would be grateful for an urgent response as they are also discussing dates with the French, West Germans and Belgians.

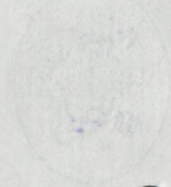
