

De of Charles Message to New Portuguese President The Portuguese elect their new President on Sunday, 16 February. The two candidates still in the field are both known to the Prime Minister. Professor Freitas do Amaral, of the conservative Christian Democrats, met the Prime Minister on a visit to London last December. Dr Mario Soares, until last October Prime Minister of Portugal, was Mrs Thatcher's host in April 1984; he paid a return visit to London in November of that year. In view of these personal contacts, a message from the Prime Minister to the eventual winner would be appropriate. A very close result seems inevitable and I accordingly enclose a telegram with draft alternative messages so that our Ambassador can move quickly whatever the outcome.
