MEETING WITH PRESIDENT CHUN

You will welcome President Chun at a guard of honour ceremony in the Foreign Office courtyard at 0845. You should arrive at 0842. I attach a note of the procedure. You will notice that the General Officer Commanding is now Major General Airy. After the President has reviewed the guard of honour, Mrs. Chun's car will pull up and she will be driven away before you and the President walk across to No.10 Downing Street.

I suggest that the talks themselves take place in the Cabinet Room since by the time interpreters are included we shall number 10 people.

You have already read the briefs but I attach them in case you wish to refresh your memory. There are cards in the inside pocket.

GUARD OF HONOUR - Procedure

1. A Guard of Honour found by 1st Battalion Irish Guards under the command of Major B W F Holt with the Regimental Colour, the Band of the Grenadier Guards and the Corps of Drums of the Battalion will be formed in the Foreign and Commonwealth Office Quadrangle on Wednesday 9 April at 0845 hours to greet His Excellency President Chun Doo Hwan of the Republic of Korea. Embassy staff and other spectators are requested to arrive not later than 0830 hours.

2. At 0835 hours The Rt Hon Sir Geoffrey Howe MP, Secretary of State for Foreign and Commonwealth Affairs, will arrive in the Quadrangle; he will be met to the left of the dais by Major General Christopher Airy, General Officer Commanding London District, who will be accompanied by Lieutenant Colonel E B L Armitstead, Brigade Major, Household Division. At 0837 hours the members of the Official Suite will arrive at the Foreign and Commonwealth Office Quadrangle by car via King Charles Street. They will alight from their cars just beyond the dais (ie to the east of the latter) where they will be received by The Rt Hon Sir Geoffrey Howe MP. They will remain on the east side of the Main Archway (see diagram attached). The cars will proceed to the east of the King Charles Street Archway and await the arrival of the President and Mrs Chun. As soon as these cars have entered the Quadrangle the cars of the Official Suite should proceed to park in the south west corner of the Quadrangle.

3. At 0842 hours the Prime Minister will arrive at the Foreign and Commonwealth Office Quadrangle through the main Archway; she will be met at the Archway by Major General Christopher Airy. The Major General will then escort the Prime Minister to the right (west) of the dais where she will receive the President and Mrs Chun.

4. At 0845 hours the President and Mrs Chun will arrive at the Foreign and Commonwealth Office via King Charles Street.

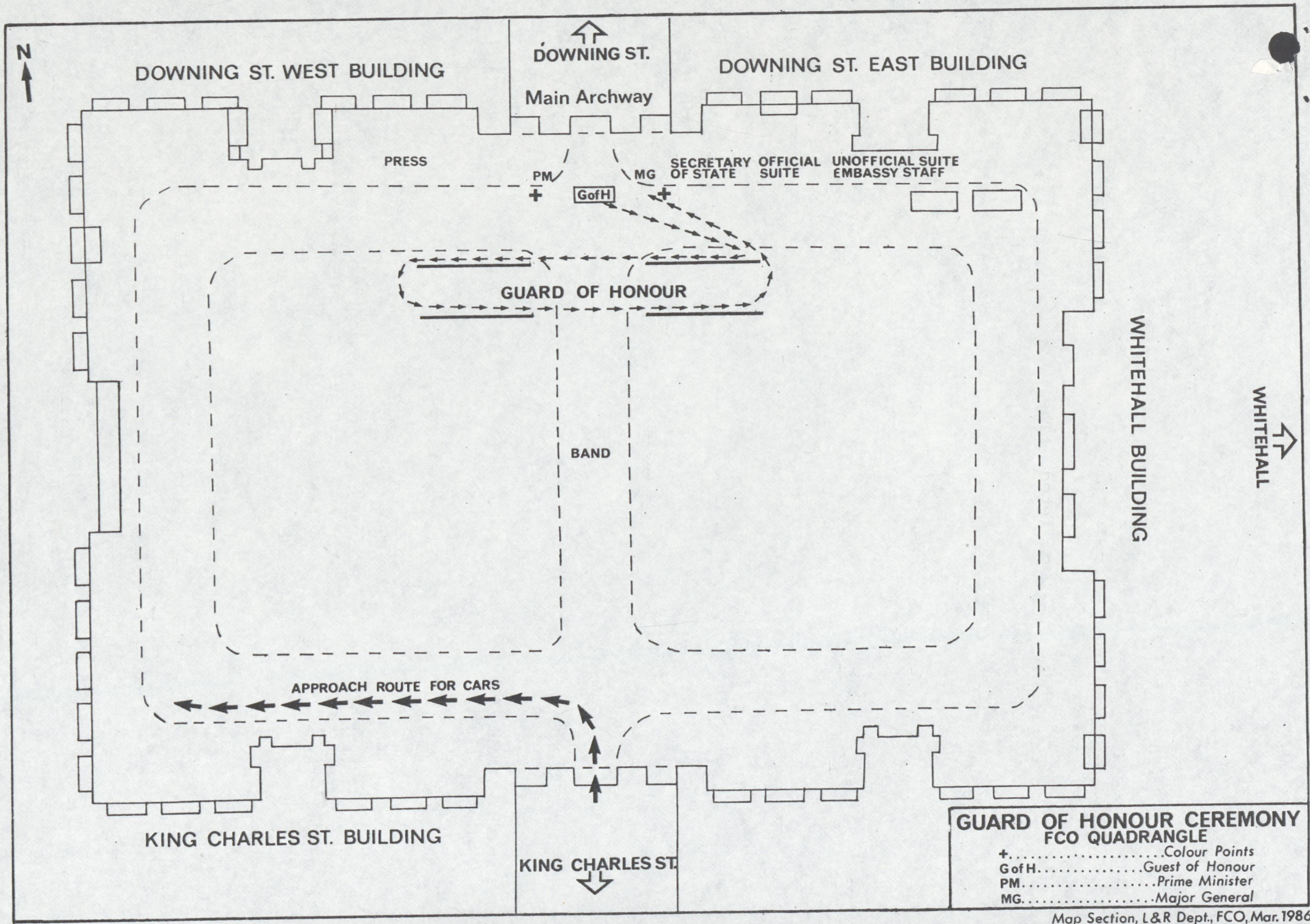
5. The Prime Minister will welcome them and present Major General Airy, who will escort the President to his place on the dais. The Prime Minister and Mrs Chun will then take up a position on his right and behind the dais. The Captain of the Guard of Honour will order "Guard of Honour, Royal Salute, Present Arms" and the Band will play the Republic of Korea National Anthem. After the Captain of the Guard of Honour has ordered "Shoulder Arms" and "Order Arms", he will present his Guard of Honour to the President and the Major General will accompany the President and the Guard Commander on the inspection. The President's A.D.C. will not follow them.

6. The Prime Minister and Mrs Chun should remain in the vicinity of the dais with the Brigade Major until the inspection is completed and the Major General has accompanied the President back to the dais. Mrs Chun will take leave of the President and the Prime Minister at her car, which will draw up in front of the dais immediately the inspection has been completed. The Prime Minister will then escort the President to 10 Downing Street. Those accompanying the President for the talks with the Prime Minister at 10 Downing Street will follow.

7. Meanwhile, the Major General and the Brigade Major will have taken their leave of the President and will authorise the dispersal of the Guard of Honour once Mrs Chun has left the Quadrangle and the President has departed for 10 Downing Street. Other members of the Official Suite will remain in the Quadrangle until the Guard of Honour has dispersed.

Wet Weather Programme

8. In the event of wet weather the Parade will not be cancelled. The programme will continue as scheduled up to the point where the inspection of the Guard of Honour should begin. If there is heavy rain at that point in the programme, and the President does not wish to inspect the Guard of Honour, the Prime Minister should lead him to 10 Downing Street.

President Chun Doo Hwan's Official Visit

**Address at a Dinner Hosted by
The Right Honourable Margaret Thatcher,
Prime Minister of the United Kingdom of
Great Britain and Northern Ireland**

**London
April 8, 1986**

(Translation)

Madam Prime Minister, My Lords,

It is a great honor and privilege for me to be the first Korean head of state to pay an official visit to Britain, a Free World leader, which has evolved the world's oldest democratic institutions. I am deeply grateful to you, Madam Prime Minister for having spoken so warmly and kindly about my country and also for having arranged this sumptuous dinner for my wife and me.

In particular, I consider it a very significant experience for me to be directly exposed to the statesmanship of Prime Minister Thatcher who, with unwavering political convictions and outstanding leadership abilities, has inspired the British people with new self-confidence and hope and who is also playing a leading role in promoting world peace and prosperity.

In the latter 19th century, when Korea was finally emerging out of its long isolation, Britain became the first European country to conclude a treaty of friendship and commerce with us. Ever since then our two nations have consistently maintained amicable relations with

each other. Following the end of World War II, your country made an invaluable contribution to the founding of the government of the Republic of Korea. Especially when Communist North Korea launched a massive surprise attack on the South in 1950, British troops fought side by side with Republic of Korea soldiers to repel the aggressors and defend justice and freedom.

I am visiting your country with the aim of opening a new chapter in our bilateral relations as our two countries enter the second century of their formal contacts. I am confident that this can be done on the strength of our century-old ties of friendship enhanced by an alliance in war.

Emerging stronger from many decades of incessant sufferings and trials, the Republic of Korea has now grown into a responsible member of the international community. I am confident that on the threshold of the 21st century, our two nations can develop ever closer ties of friendship and cooperation truly based on the principles of reciprocity and equality and become fully reliable partners in building a global village of peace and justice.

In view of the fact that trade between Korea and

the United Kingdom increased fivefold over the past 10 years, I believe it will be able to continue to expand rapidly under the principle of free trade. I am hopeful that the businessmen of our two countries will work together increasingly more actively in the future, especially to increase joint investments in various industries in each other's country. It would also be highly desirable to intensify bilateral cooperation in the advanced scientific and technological fields.

Madam Prime Minister,

For over 40 years, a state of deadly military confrontation has persisted on the Korean peninsula, a focal point of East-West contention. Establishing lasting peace on the peninsula will have, I believe, a direct bearing not only on the well-being and reunification of the Korean people but also on the peace of Northeast Asia and the rest of the world including Europe. I hope that our two countries will achieve a common perception of the Korean situation and other international issues of common concern and endeavor together to promote peace and prosperity throughout the world.

In this context, I think it very significant that Seoul,

which was reduced to ashes by the Korean War, should be chosen to host the 1988 Summer Olympics, a festival of global peace and harmony. I expect all freedom-loving nations of the world, including the United Kingdom, to extend support to ensure the success of the Seoul Olympics.

Madam Prime Minister,

I am confident that the exchange of summit visits between Korea and Britain that is now taking place will be a model of friendship and cooperation between the Atlantic and the Pacific—the two most dynamic international political and economic centers. I vow to work closely together with you toward that end.

Distinguished guests,

Please join me in a toast to the good health and well-being of Her Majesty, the Queen and Prime Minister Thatcher and also to the eternal friendship between Korea and Britain.



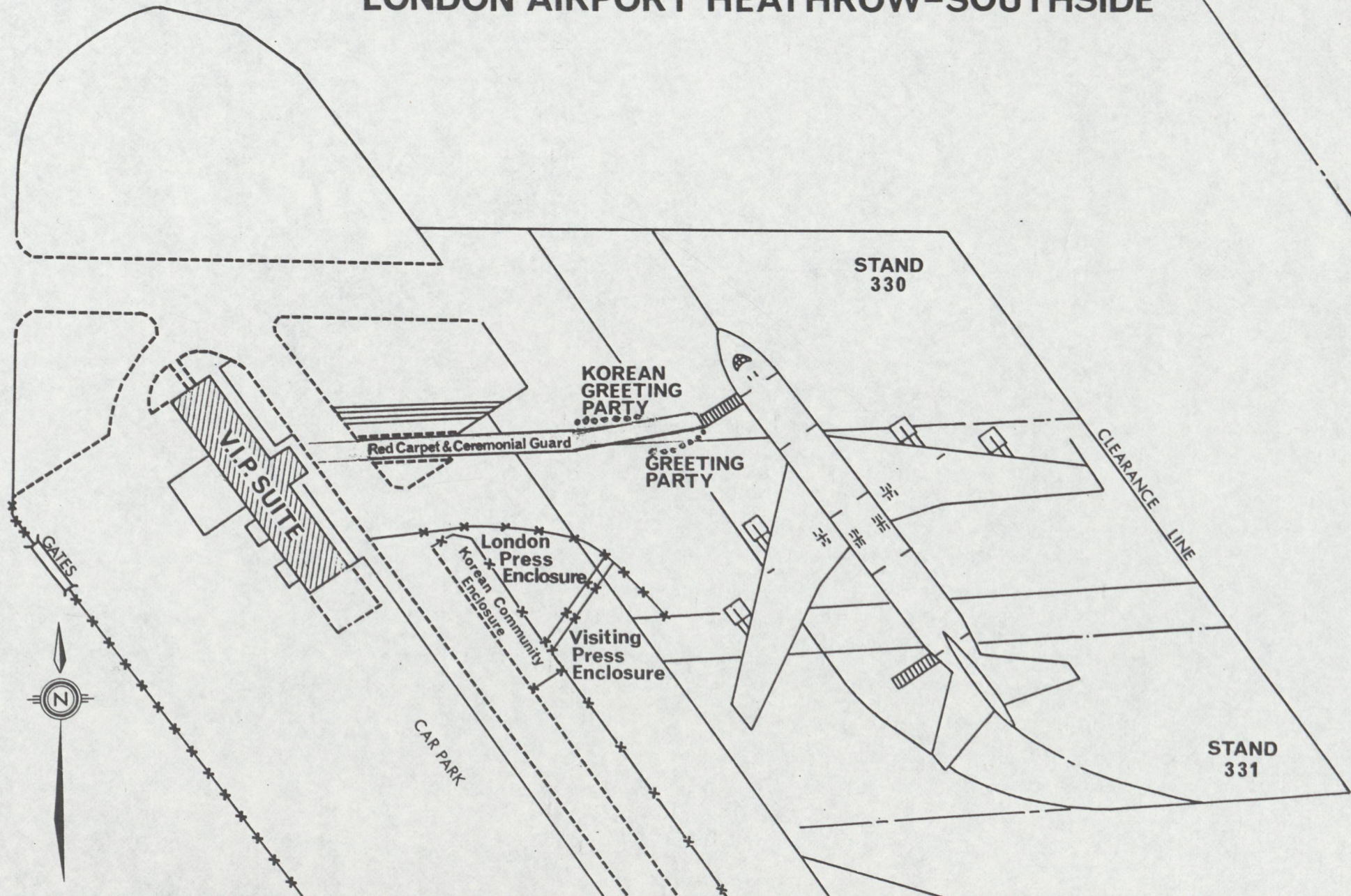
