MY TEL NO 502: CHERNOBYL NUCLEAR ACCIDENT: SOVIET RESPONSE

- 1. HE WAS SUMMONED TO THE SOVIET MEA AT 2000 LOCAL THESE EVENING, 30 APRIL, BY FIRST DEPUTY FOREIGN MEMBERER KOVALEV.

 KOVALEV HAD WHITH HIM PETROSYANTS (CHARRMAN OF THE STATE COMMETTEE FOR THE PEACEFUL USE OF ATOMIC ENERGY) AND YAGODIN (MINISTER FOR HEIGHER EDUCATION). THIS HEIGH-POWERED TRIO HAD CLEARLY BEEN HINSTRUCTED BY THE SOVIET LEADERSHIP TO CONDUCT A BELATED PUBLIC RELATIONS EXERCISE TO ATTEMPT TO RESTORE SOVIET CREDIBILITY SEMECUN AND TO RETRIEVE THE DAMAGE DONE BY THE CHERNOBYL EPISODE TO THE SOVIET UNION'S HINTERNATIONAL REPUTATION. THE MAIN POINTS HIN OUR DISCUSSION, WHICH LASTED FOR FORTY FIVE MINUTES, WERE AS FOLLOWS.
- 2. KOVALEV SAND THAT A FURTHER STATEMENT BY THE SOVEET GOVERNMENT WOULD BE PUBLISHED TONIGHT GIVING MORE DETAILS OF THE AFTERMATH OF THE CHERNOBYL ACCIDENT (LIT HAS NOW APPEARED ON TASS - TEXT AN MIFT). DUE TO MEASURES ALREADY TAKEN BY THE SOVIET AUTHORNITHES, THE LEVEL OF RADIOACTHINHTY IN THE VICINITY OF CHERNOBYL HAD SUBSTANTIALLY SUBSTIDED. HT WAS BEING CONSTANTLY MEASURED. THERE HAD BEEN NO CHAIN REACTION IN THE CHERNOBYL PLANT AND THE REACTOR IN WHICH THE ACCIDENT HAD OCCURRED WAS ''IN A SUBDUED STATE''. THE CASUALTY FAGURES PUT OUT BY FORENGN NEWS AGENCILES WERE ENTURELY MINCORRECT: ONLY 2 PEOPLE, KOVALEY REAFFARMED. HAD BEEN KHALLED. 197 HAD BEEN HOSPATALHSED AND OF THESE ABOUT 50 HAD SHNCE BEEN DISCHARGED. ALTHOUGH THE SOVIET GOVERNMENT UNDERSTOOD THE ANXIETHES AROUSED BY THE ACCIDENT, THERE WAS NOW NO CAUSE FOR CONCERN. LAFE HAN KHEY AND HATS SURROUNDING DISTRICTS WAS NORMAL: FACTORIES AND FARMS WERE FUNCTIONING AS USUAL. THE SOVIET AUTHORITHES RECOGNISED THEFR RESPONSIBILITY TO PROVIDE MEDICAL CARE FOR ALL WHO MIGHT NEED AT, ANCLUDING FORE IGNERS. HE REQUESTED ME TO REASSURE THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT THAT ALL WAS NOW WELL: HE SAND THUS. AS HE WOULD BE SAYING TO OTHER AMBASSADORS, ON THE DIRECT INSTRUCTIONS OF THE SOVIET LEADERSHIP CONFIDENTIAL /3.

- 3. PETROSYANTS THEN MADE A MORE CONTENTIOUS STATEMENT, ARGUING THAT REPROACHES (ENCLUDING THAT WHICH IN HAD VOICED TO SUSLOV EARLIER (IN THE DAY) ADDRESSED TO THE SOVIET GOVERNMENT WERE UNJUSTIFIED, THAT FOREIGN REACTIONS WERE OVERDRAMATISED AND BASED ON RUMOURS, AND THAT THE SOVIET HANDLING OF THE CHERNOBYL MINCHDENT HAD BEEN ENTIRELY CORRECT. WIT HAD TAKEN THE AMERICANS SEVERAL MONTHS TO DISCLOSE THE DETAILS OF WHAT HAD OCCURRED AT THREE MILE ISLAND: AND AN ACCOUNT OF THE WINDSCALE ACCIDENT IN 1957 HAD NOT EXACTLY BEEN RELEASED 'ON THE FOLLOWING DAY'. THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT'S OFFER OF ASSISTANCE HAD BEEN NOTED WHITH GRATHTUDE BUT THE SOVIET UNION DISPOSED OF ALL THE EXPERTISE AND TECHNOLOGY NECESSARY FOR DEALING WHITH THE ACCIDENT AND HITS AFTERMATH AND NO OUTSIDE HELP WAS REQUIRED.
- 4. YAGODIN THEN SAID THAT RADIATION LEVELS FOR KHEV

 AND ELSEWHERE WERE BEING CONSTANTLY MONITORED AND MEDICAL

 CHECKS HAD BEEN OFFERED TO ALL LOCAL INHABITANTS. THIS

 FACILITY WAS READILY AVAILABLE TO FOREIGN STUDENTS AS WELL.

 RADIATION CHECKS ON PEOPLE WHO HAD BEEN EVACUATED FROM THE VICINITY

 OF THE ACCIDENT SHOWED THAT THERE DOSAGE WAS 'LOWER THAN

 THE PROFESSIONAL NORM, NAMELY 0.0075 MILLI-RONTGENS PER HOUR'

 AND BY YESTERDAY, 29 APRIL, HAD FALLEN TO ZERO. HE, TOO,

 URGED ME TO REASSURE OUR STUDENTS, WHOSE DEPARTURE HE VERY

 MUCH REGRETTED. KOVALEV ADDED THAT OUR STUDENTS COULD BE

 GIVEN MEDICAL CHECK-UPS AT THE MOSCOW POLYCLINIAC FROM

 0900 ONWARDS ON 1 MAY AND HE WAS ASKED TO BRING THIS

 FACILIATY TO THERE ATTENTION. (THE MFA HAVE SHACE TELEPHONED

 TO SAY THAT THESE MEDICAL CHECKS ARE TO BE COMPULSORY FOR

 ALL THOSE WISHING TO FLY OUT).
- 5. AN ANSWER TO MY QUESTION, PETROSYANTS SAID DIRECTLY THAT THE FIRE IN THE REACTOR WHERE THE ACCORDENT HAD OCCURRED HAD BEEN EXTENDUESHED.
- 6. AT VARIOUS POINTS ON THE DISCUSSION OF STRESSED THAT
 FRANK DISCLOSURE BY THE SOVOET AUTHOROTOLES AT THE OUTSET
 COULD HAVE AVERTED THE ANXIETHES AND CONCERNS WHOCH INNEVITABLY
 PROLIFERATED ONCE THE ACCIDENT HAD BEEN DETECTED FROM
 OUTSIDE THE SOVIET UNION: AND THAT THE RESULTIONS LOSS OF
 CONFIDENCE, FOR EXAMPLE BY FOREIGN STUDENTS, WAS PROBABLY
 HEREVERSIBLE. HE DISPUTED PETROSYANTS' PARALLEL BETWEEN
 CHERNOBYL AND THREE MILE ISLAND/WANDSCALE, POINTING OUT THAT
 THE LATTER ACCIDENTS HAD NOT AFFECTED ANY OTHER COUNTRIES.
 HE ALSO MADE HET CLEAR, WHILE WELCOMING THE SOVIET DECISION
 TO RELEASE FURTHER DETAILS OF WHAT HAD HAPPENED, THAT WE STILL
 EXPECTED DETAILED ANSWERS TO THE SPECIFIC QUESTIONS WHICH HE HAD
 TRANSMITTED TO THE MFA EARLIER HIN THE DAY. THIS SHOULD BE

THE BEGINNING OF A DHALOGUE HAN THE HINTERESTS OF FUTURE NUCLEAR SAFETY, AND NOT THE END OF HET. HI THANKED THOSE CONCERNED FOR THE COOPERATHON WHICH HAD SO FAR BEEN SHOWN BY THE SOVHET AUTHORISTHES HAN ENABLHING OUR STUDENTS TO LEAVE KHEV AND MINSK ONCE THEY HAD DECIDED, OF THEHR OWN FREE WILL AND WHITHOUT ANY URGING FROM US, TO DO SO.

OUR DEPARTING STUDENTS, WHEN THEY ARRIVE IN MOSCOW TOMORROW (1 MAY) TO BE INFORMED OF THE CONSIDERATIONS PUT FORWARD BY KOVALEV AND HIS COLLEAGUES. THIS WILL NOT BE DONE HIN ANY WHICH COULD BE SEEN AS AN ATTEMPT TO PINFLUENCE THE STUDENTS' DECISION OR TO EXCULPATE THE RUSSHANS: BUT IN THINK HIT WOULD BE WRONG NOT TO SHARE WITH THEM ALL THE MAPORMATION AVAILABLE TO US, HINCLUDING WHAT THE RUSSHANS HAVE NOW TOLD US. IN SHALL BE VERY SURPRISED, HIN ANY CASE, HIF HIT CUTS MUCH HICE WITH THEM. HAN THUS CONTEXT HE SHOULD BE GRATEFUL FOR URGENT EXPERT COMMENT (DESKBY DGODZ ON 1 MAY) ON THE RADIATIONS DOSAGE CUTED BY YAGODIM (PARAGRAPH 4 ABOVE).
