THE LESSONS OF CHERNOBYL

The Prime Minister was grateful for your minute of 21 November about the lessons of Chernobyl and she has seen the first report circulated as CCU(86)9. The Prime Minister is content that the further work described in the report should be put in hand, subject to the views of colleagues, and that she should announce the stage reached so far in an arranged written answer. She looks forward to seeing your proposal for this.

The Prime Minister is concerned about the time which has been taken to produce this first report, though she recognises that a large number of interests had to be consulted. She has asked that the next stage should be taken forward as a matter of urgency.
