- (1) a report on the outcome of yesterday's ECOFIN Council, and in particular the successful completion of the capital movements directive. The Chancellor apparently feels the form of words he accepted on a study of tax differences is pretty meaningless.
- (2) NHS Review. He want to mention the first of the meetings between DHSS and the Treasury Ministers, agreed at the last meeting of your group, which took place last Friday.
- (3) The markets I am not aware the Chancellor wants to put any operational points to you.
- (4) Economic Summit probably no need to discuss in the bilateral as you will be having a full briefing meeting tomorrow morning.
