Foreign and Commonwealth Office London SW1A 2AH 6 october 1988 Dear Charles Prime Minister's Visit to Poland Despite repeated and insistent efforts by the Embassy, the latest of which was made yesterday, our Ambassador reports that he has so far been unable to obtain a response from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs about new dates for the Prime Minister's visit. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs say that, because Jaruzelski and other members of the Polish leadership are so heavily tied up with the political changes now taking place, they have not yet been able to give the matter their attention. That is a manifestly thin excuse and the Ambassador concludes that the Poles may be apprehensive that the Prime Minister's visit would give a boost to Solidarity at a particularly inopportune moment. He advises therefore that a quick personal message from the Prime Minister to General Jaruzelski might help forestall a negative reply. I enclose a suitable draft.
