SECRETARY OF STATE'S MEETING WITH SECRETARY BAKER: MIDDLE EAST

- 1. THE SECRETARY OF STATE ASKED ABOUT PROGRESS IN THE MIDDLE EAST.
 HE HOPED THE US WERE NOT LOSING PATIENCE. WAS THERE ANYTHING WE
 COULD DO? BAKER SAID THAT HE HAD SPOKEN TO ABDAL MAGUID THAT
 MORNING. ALTHOUGH HE WAS A LITTLE MORE OPTIMISTIC, HE WARNED
 AGAINST EXPECTING AN EARLY TRILATERAL MEETING. THE PROBLEM
 REMAINED THE QUESTION OF PALESTINIAN REPRESENTATION. IT WAS CLEAR
 THAT ARAFAT WAS UNDER PRESSURE. HE HOPED WE COULD EMPHASISE TO THE
 PLO THAT THEY WOULD NOT WANT TO BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR FAILURE,
 THEY SHOULD BE SATISFIED WITH BEING INVITED TO ACQUIESCE IN THE
 COMPOSITION OF THE PALESTINIAN DELEGATION, AND NOT INSIST ON
 BEING ASKED FOR APPROVAL. THEY SHOULD CONCENTRATE ON SUBSTANCE
 NOT SYMBOLS. NOW WOULD BE A GOOD TIME TO SEND SUCH A MESSAGE:
 THE US HAD JUST FINALISED THE TEXT OF THEIR LETTER OF ASSURANCE
 TO THE EGYPTIANS.
- 2. THE SECRETARY OF STATE MENTIONED CROWN
 PRINCE HASSAN'S CONCERN ABOUT ISRAELI SETTLEMENTS
 IN THE OCCUPIED TERRITORIES. BAKER SAID THE US HAD MADE THEIR
 CONCERNS AS CLEAR TO THE ISRAELIS AS THEY KNEW HOW. NO US
 MONEY WOULD BE AVAILABLE FOR SETTLEMENT OF SOVIET REFUGEES IN
 THE OCCUPIED TERRITORIES. BUT IN PRACTICE HE HAD TO ADMIT THAT
 QUOTE MONEY WAS FUNGIBLE UNQUOTE.
