I note that the Attorney General has confirmed that he is content with these. I have shown them to the Prime Minister, who is equally

satisfied. She also agrees that authority to implement essential elements in them should, in extremis, be delegated to the British Force Commander Middle East, provided retrospective Ministerial authority is sought as soon as possible afterwards.
