A reference to the interests of the Islanders had been introduced, which we were free to define While the reference to the cessation of hostilities as we wished. was not fully satisfactory from the UK point of view it was still a valuable improvement to the draft.
- Louis said that the United States believed that they would not be taking a position prejudicial to the United Kingdom on sovereignty or self-determination by voting for the amended They would not press for early negotiations or any that the views of the Falkland Islanders should be g They had not forgotten Argentina's use of force but feared they would give the wrong signal to moderate opinion in Argentina if they did not vote in favour.
