If the Cabinet decides on Thursday morning both to abate the TSRB's recommendations and to announce that decision, along with the decisions about the Civil Service Arbitration Tribunal and the other review bodies on Thursday

afternoon, we shall need to consider how best to handle Lord Plowden.

2. It is, as you know, the normal procedure to give the Chairmen of the review bodies advance notice of the Government's decision on their reports. The Secretary of State for Social Services will, I understand, be arranging to see the Chairman of the Doctors and Dentists Review Body on Wednesday, evening. It would clearly not be possible for you to see Lord Plowden yourself between the Cabinet's decision on Thursday and the time of an announcement on Thursday afternoon. I therefore suggest that the best course would be for you to write to Lord Plowden on the lines of the draft attached, which would need to be revised after Cabinet to incorporate the substance of the Cabinet's decision. If you agree, we could arrange for a letter to be submitted to you for signature over Thursday lunchtime, and I would try to make arrangements to see Lord Plowden early on Thursday afternoon to deliver it personally to him.
