The Prime Minister considers that, if this report is well-founded, it would be as well for us to consider the preparation of a paper for the summit, so that the running is not left to President Mitterrand and his

associates, who are likely to produce more prescriptive and interventionist proposals than other heads of government attending the summit will be disposed to

Could you please consider this point and advise the Prime Minister.
