FOLLOWING FROM PRINTATE SECRETARY

SECRETARY OF STATE'S DISCUSSION WHITH NECARAGUAN FOREIGN MINHSTER,

D'ESCOTO.

- 1. D'ESCOTO SAND HE WOULD BE LEAVING FOR EUROPE SIN MID-OCTOBER.

 THUS WOULD NOT AFFECT THE DEADLINE OF 15 OCTOBER FOR THE SUBMISSISSION

 OF WRITTEN COMMENTS BY THE FINE CENTRAL AMERICAN STATES ON THE

 CONTADORA DOCUMENTS. NEICARAGUA HAD ALREADY DONE SO AND ACCEPTED

 THE DRAFT AS SIT NOW STOOD.
- 2. ON THE NEWCARAGUAN ELECTRIONS, D'ESCOTO SAND THAT THEY WOULD TAKE PLACE ON 4 NOVEMBER. THE NEWCARAGUAN GOVERNMENT HAD RECENTLY BEEN LIN TOUCH WHITH THE PRESENDENT OF COLOMBINA, SR BETANCUR, ABOUT A POSSEMBLE POSTPONEMENT OF THE ELECTRONS. AS A RESULT OF THESE CONVERSATIONS, THE NEWCARAGUANS HAD EXTENDED THE ELECTORAL REGISTRATION PERIOD UNTINL 30 SEPTEMBER.
- 3. D'ESCOTO CONTINUED THAT ARTURO CRUZ'S (THE LEADER OF THE OPPOSITION DEMOCRATIC COORDINADORA) CANDIDATURE HAD ORIGINATED IN WASHINGTON ONLY 4 DAYS BEFORE THE INNITIAL REGISTRATION PERIOD (21 JULY 1984) WAS TO EXPIRE. CD WERE INSINSTITUTE UPON A POSTPONEMENT UNTIL 23 FEBRUARY 1985, BUT THIS PROPOSAL WAS UNACCEPTABLE TO THE INCARAGUAN GOVERNMENT, SINCE THE WINTER MONTHS OF DECEMBER, JANUARY AND FEBRUARY WERE HARVEST MONTHS. MOREOVER, THE FSLN COULD NOT CONTINUE TO MAKE CONCESSIONS TOWARDS THE CD WINTHOUT BEING CRIMINGISED BY OTHER OPPOSITION PARTIES WHICH HAD ALREADY REGISTERED. CRUZ WAS WASHINGTON'S CANDIDATE, BUT THE ELECTIONS WERE NOT TO BE HELD IN WASHINGTON.
- 4. THE SECRETARY OF STATE ASKED FOR D'ESCOTO'S VIEW ON WHY THE OTHER CENTRAL AMERICAN STATES WERE SO CONCERNED AT THE SHIZE OF THE NICARAGUAN ARMY AND THAT THE REPORTED POSSIBILITY THAT NICARAGUA MIGHT ACQUIRE MIGS. D'ESCOTO SAID THAT NICARAGUA WAS FACED WITH AGGRESSION BY UP TO 20,000 MEN TRAINED, EQUIPPED AND DIRECTED BY THE AMERICAN CHA. THE PROSPECT OF DIRECT US INTERVENTION WAS REAL.
- OF US MATERIALOUS WAS NOT SHARED BY OTHERS. THERE WAS REAL CONCERN NOT ONLY IN THE US, BUT ALSO IN THE REGION, ABOUT MICARAGUAN MATERIALOUS. D'ESCOTO REPLAD THAT MICARAGUA HAD GENUMELY SOUGHT A LESSENING OF TENSIONS IN THE AREA AND THAS COULD MINVOLVE ARMS LIMITS. NUCLARAGUA HAD PUBLICLY ACCEPTED THE CONTADORA DRAFT FOR THE ACT OF PEACE AND CO-OPERATION. THE BALL WAS NOW IN OTHER PEOPLE'S COURTS.

6. MAN CONCLUSION, THE SECRETARY OF STATE FMINALLY RAMSED THE MISSUE OF RAY HOOKER, THE ATLANTIC COAST FSLN CANDIDATE KINDNAPPED AT THE BEGINNING OF SEPTEMBER WHO HAS FOR THE SUBJECT OF REPRESENTATIONS FROM A NUMBER OF BRINTISH MPS. HE ASKED OF THE NUCLEAR GUANS HAD ANY NEWS OF MR HOOKER. D'ESCOTO REPLINED THAT HE KNEW ONLY THAT HOOKER WAS STULL ON ARDE HANDS, BUT HAD NO FURTHER KNOWLEDGE OF THE AFFARR.
