MICARAGUA: MNAUGURATHON OF DANNEL ORTEGA AS PRESHIDENT

SUMMARY

1. DANNEL ORTEGA WAS DULY SWORN IN AT A RELATIVELY SUBDUED

CEREMONY ATTENDED BY FINDEL CASTRO BUT NOT MANY OTHERS OF STATURE.

ORTEGA DELIVERED A MODERATE AND CONCELLIATORY SPEECH.

DETAIL

- 2. AT HES MANAUGURATION (WHICH IN ATTENDED AS BREITHISH DELEGATE)
 DANNIEL ORTEGA MADE A CONCREMATORY SPEECH MUCH OF WHICH WAS DEVOTED
 TO FOREMAN RELATIONS. HE REAFFREMED COMMITMENT TO PRINCIPLES OF
 PLURALISM, MIXED ECONOMY AND NON-ALIGNMENT, DECLARING ALSO THAT
 HE WOULD STRIVE TO REPRESENT ALL OF THE NICARAGUANS, NOT
 JUST THE SANDIAMISTA FRONT. HIS REFERENCES TO THE UNLITED STATES
 WERE RELATIVELY RESTRAINED AND HE DESCRIBED THE MANZANILLO TALKS
 AS A "MAGNIFICENT OPPORTUNITY". HE ALSO SPOKE APPROVINGLY OF
 CONTADORA AND OF THE DINALOGUE IN EL SALVADOR.
- 3. THE ONLY NOVEL POINT WAS THE OFFER BY ORTEGA OF A TYPE OF AMNESTY TO THOSE FINGHTING AGAINST HIS REGIME. HE SAID THE GOVERNMENT WAS READY TO ACCEPT THEM BACK OF THEY FORST HANDED OVER THEOR ARMS TO THE HONDURAN OR COSTA ROCAN AUTHORITIES, HIN COOPERATION WITH THE HINTERNATIONAL RED CROSS. HIT SEEMS ON FACT DOUBTFUL WHETHER THOSE WILL HAVE VERY MUCH PRACTICAL EFFECT SHACE MOST CONTRAS ALREADY HAVE THE OPPORTUNISTY TO EXPLOIT THE EXISTING GENERAL AMNESTY (ONLY CERTAIN CONTRA LEADERS ARE EXCLUDED UNDER NOT). BUT ORTEGA NO DOUBT HOPED THAT HOSE WORDS WOULD HAVE AT LEAST SOME PSYCHOLOGORICAL IMPACT, AND HE MAY DERIVE ENCOURAGEMENT FROM THE RECENT SHAGNS OF A LESS PLIMANT HONDURAN ATTRITUDE TOWARDS THE CONTRAS.
- 4. ORTEGA RECOGNISED THE SERIOUSNESS OF THE COUNTRY'S ECONOMIC CRUSIS, AND ACKNOWLEDGED THAT THERE WAS NO SHORT TERM SOLUTION. HE DECLARED THAT THE PRIVATE SECTOR STILL REPRESENTED OVER HALF OF THE PRODUCTIVE ECONOMY AND THAT THE GOVERNMENT DID NOT MINTEND TO CHANGE THE BALANCE.

- 5. THE MOST NEWSWORTHY ASPECT OF THE OCCASION WAS THE UNHERALDED ATTENDANCE OF FILDEL CASTRO. BUT THE GENERAL LEVEL OF ATTENDANCE WAS NOT PARTICULARLY IMPRESSIVE: APART FROM CONTADORA AND SOME LATIN AMERICAN MINISTERNAL DELEGATIONS (PLUS SWEDISH AND FRENCH MINISTERS FROM WESTERN EUROPE) THE HIGH LEVEL REPRESENTATIVES WERE LARGELY FROM COMMUNIST STATES. NONE OF THE CENTRAL AMERICAN STATES SENT DELEGATES APART FROM GUATEMALA - THERE AMBASSADOR - AND BELLEZE. HET WAS EXPECTED THAT THE UNLITED STATES WOULD BE REPRESENTED BY AMBASSADOR BERGOLD, BUT NONE OF US WAS ABLE TO SPOT HIM. PROMINENT AMONG THE NON-GOVERNMENTAL GUESTS WAS MR NEWL KINNOCK.
- THE ATMOSPHERE WAS RESTRAINED WHITH THE PUBLIC REACTION LESS ENTHUSHASTIC THAN SOME EXPECTED. BUSHOP PABLO VEGA WAS PERMITTED TO MAKE AN ADDRESS ON BEHALF OF THE CHURCH WHOSE IMPLIED CRITICISM HAD A RATHER SOBERING EFFECT AND PROMPTED CASTRO TO ENGAGE THE BUSHOP IN PROLONGED CONVERSATION.
