Henry Catto telephoned me this morning on his return from Bermuda to say that the President and all his entourage had been thoroughly enthusiastic about the talks, which they had found very productive and substantial. They felt the atmosphere had been very good and they had been full of praise for the very clear thinking you had brought to bear on all the issues. They in particular appreciated the feeling of informality and relaxation which had made it possible to get really deeply into the subjects. Henry Catto's personal view was that it had been a much better meeting in this respect than Camp David.
