In the time available it has not been possible to secure from the industry specific undertaking to make savings in particular areas. However, taking account of the latest view of electricity sales next year (somewhat improved), the prospect that coal stocks may in fact rise by less than 4m tonnes, and the possibility that some payments to suppliers could be advanced from 1983/84 to 1982/83 without prejudicing the 1982/83 EFL, I conclude that there is likely to be scope for savings of the order which you have proposed.
