ABOLITION OF DOMESTIC RATES ETC (SCOTLAND) BILL CLAUSE 5: TIMING OF REVALUATIONS

Thank you for your letter of 21 November.

I note your concern that the provisions in clause 5(1) and (2) of the Legislation Committee print of my Bill could be interpreted as casting doubt on our commitment that revaluations should take part north and south of the border in 1990. These provisions were included in the Bill simply in order to place the statutory framework north and south of the border on a similar footing. I can accept, however, the concerns you express and in the light of the assurances you have given including your intention, in due course, to reintroduce a requirement for regular revaluations I am content to remove subsections (1) and (2) of clause 5 from the Bill in the version in which it will be published.
