COMMUNITY CHARGE: MARRIED AND UNMARRIED COUPLES

I have seen a copy of Quintin Hailsham's letter of 9 April to you on this subject.

In view of the importance that Quintin attaches to the point, I am willing to adopt the approach he suggested earlier. This will involve somewhat different rules for married and unmarried couples: in the former case, the burden of proof will be on the local authority to show that a couple lived together before marriage. I confirm that joint liability would, in any case, extend only to debts in so far as these were incurred after the couple started living together.

This is the approach I will adopt in the Bill. I may, however, need to return to the issue if there is criticism of these arrangements during the Bill's passage through Parliament.

I am copying this letter to the Prime Minister, the Lord Chancellor, members of $E(\mathrm{LF})$ and Sir Robert Armstrong.
