NNDR MULIPLIER AND THE NNDR DISTRIBUTABLE AMOUNT

I very much agree with the arguments in your letter of 25 October to Norman Lamont and in particular that the NNDR multiplier should be set at 35.5 pence if possible, and no higher than 35.6 pence. Rates are an important element of business costs and should be minimised as far as possible in the present climate of depressed business confidence. I am also particularly concerned about the position of small businesses who are still, as you know, very unhappy with the transitional provisions despite the recent concessions.
