Thank you for your letter of 24 August.

I recognise the wider implications and accept your Department's decision, for the reasons that you provide.

The points you make do not, however, remove my concerns about the authorities who have lost out in the way the 1989/90 debt has been handled in the new system. They may well return to the charge when they know that there will be no change. There is little in your letter which we could use as an explanation to those authorities, and I think it will therefore be necessary to consider a convincing "public" explanation which could be used if the long-term effects of the handling of 1989/90 debt come under increasing criticism.

I am copying this letter to the other members of E(LG) and to Sir Robin Butler.
