- (iii) The progress of Star Chamber discussions (minutes enclosed);
- (iv) The health of the Lord Chancellor. On this you will wish to see the letter (at Flag C) from the Lord Chancellor's GP which is dated 9 October, but which was received here only after we left for Vancouver;
- (v) Chairmanship of the Conservative Party.

I should be glad to have a word with you at 0930 tomorrow, if this is convenient for you, about the last two items.
