SEMINARS ON HEALTH

You are meeting John Moore, Tony Newton and John O'Sullivan to discuss who should be invited to the two Chequers seminars - on 27 March and 24 April.

I attach the earlier note I put to you which incorporates the list of "helpful" names John O'Sullivan put together after consulting Tony Newton. (I have sent John Moore and Tony Newton copies of the names.) One further name subsequently suggested is Terence English, the Papworth heart surgeon.

My earlier note also raised questions about the logistics for the meetings. I suggest you might use that note as the agenda for tomorrow's meeting, with the main issues to settle being:

- (i) Which doctors should attend on 27 March? And which of them should be invited to make initial presentations?
- (ii) Which administrators should attend on 24 April? And which of them should be invited to make initial presentations?
- (iii) Which Ministers and officials should attend each of the meetings?
- (iv) What time should we schedule the meetings to start and finish? I think you are minded to have buffet lunches.
- (v) Do you want to make any further plans at this stage for a subsequent third meeting with a selection of nurses?
