NHS REVIEW: MEETING ON 24 MAY

The present plan is for the meeting of the group on 6 June to discuss greater private sector involvement; but you will want to consider whether to move on to that item or have a further discussion of independent hospitals and statutory buyers.

I also attach at Flag D some further background reading assembled by John O'Sullivan. If you have time, it would certainly be worth glancing at his items 1 and 2 - but I am conscious you have a lot of other things in the Box!
