## MEETING ON COMMUNITY CARE: 19 APRIL

This note is an attempt to sort the wheat from the chaff. The papers are:

Flag A: short steering brief by Richard Wilson. You have not seen this before. It provides an invaluable check list of the key points to cover.

<u>Flag B</u>: the fuller note by <u>Richard Wilson</u> which you saw over the weekend, setting out his thoughts on a possible phased approach.

Flag C: the promised paper from Ken Clarke, which has now arrived. It comprises a short covering minute - which you should read and a long attached paper by officials - which I suggest you skip.

Flag D: latest brief from Ian Whitehead, which you will want to go through.

Flag E: minute from the Chief Secretary, expressing his doubts about some aspects of the package. Not essential pre-reading if you give each of the Ministers a chance to raise their concerns in the meeting.
