CC SIK A WALTERS SECRET 24 PRIME MINISTER INTERVENTION, STERILISATION AND FUNDING At your recent meeting with the Chancellor, Peter Middleton and Terry Burns, there was some debate about whether the high level of intervention in 1987-88 had been genuinely sterilised and/or funded. In the light of that discussion, I asked Alan to prepare a note. Alan's note is now attached. I think the key points are: - he accepts that, in some sense at least, the intervention was automatically sterilised; - but the real problem was that, in order to keep the exchange rate at DM3, interest rates had to be kept at too low a rate, and those lower interest rates generated the excessive monetary growth; - on the funding side, it is right to stick to the policy of full funding and to avoid over-funding. This would not be a substitute for using the primary weapon of interest rates; - he remains highly sceptical abut the 'psychology' argument for intervention.
