COMMUNITY CARE: LEGISLATION

letter of 19 October David Mellor copied to me his Geoffrey Howe.

- I have two comments on David 's proposals. First, as I have indicated in my letter to Nick Scott, I agree with him that local authorities should have the power to top-up payments in respect of any genuine hard cases among people enjoying preserved entitlements to income support under the social security system.
- Secondly, I fear I am unable to agree that there should be a general power to make specific grants. My predecessor reluctantly agreed that there should be one new specific grant, in respect of the mentally ill; I cannot agree that the legislation to bring into effect the community care decisions should go further than that.
