COMMUNITY CARE

Thank you for your letter of 16 July inviting comments on your Secretary of State's draft statement on community care.

My Secretary of State has a few detailed comments on the drafting.

Page 2, line 2 would be preferable if 'cannot manage' were to read 'are not managing'. We wish to assert that as a matter of fact authorities are not doing what the sentence says, not that they are unable to do it.

Page 2, line 7 insert before 'levels' 'extremely high' and from 'which' to end of sentence. It is better not to refer to the affordability of this years community charges.

Page 2, third para, line 4: amend so that the sentence concludes:
'... local authorities have longer to prepare to discharge these
duties efficiently and at a cost which their community charge payers
can afford.' We do not need to relate the assertion to all the
duties of local authorities.

Page 3, paragraph 3 would, contrary to convention, anticipate the fact that there is to be statement on Thursday about local government finance. Amend 'tomorrow' to read 'shortly'.

Page 4, last sentence: similarly this needs to be amended to read, 'This will be taken into account in the 1991 settlement for local authority spending to be announced shortly.'
