"The Kingdom of Saudi Arabia attaches great importance to the European attitude concerning the Palestinian issue, an attitude which will be formed within the European Summit Meeting in Venice and to the importance of the support of the E.E.C. to the legitimate rights of the Palestinian people, particularly their right in self-determination.

The Kingdom, observing the aspects of retreat in the European initiative in the present stage of the Palestinian case, believes that any postponement of the case would harm its process. Israel will be the only benefactor of such a retreat.

The Kingdom hopes that her friends will push the European initiative a further step or at least support what comprises recognition of the Palestinian people of their right of self-determination at this stage."

The Royal Embassy of Saudi Arabia would appreciate a reply to this communication in order for it to be conveyed to its Foreign Office, as soon as possible.

The Royal Embassy of Saudi Arabia avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Foreign and Commonwealth Office the assurance of its highest consideration.
