EXTRACT FROM A DISCUSSION BETWEEN THE PRIME  
MINISTER AND KING HUSSEIN OF JORDAN AT 10 DOWNING  
STREET ON TUESDAY 24 JUNE AT 0915 HOURS.

The Prime Minister commented that the United Kingdom still remained out of favour with the Saudi Government and that this was very worrying. King Hussein said that as soon as he returned to Amman he would get in touch with the Saudi authorities and see what could be done. Sharif Sharaf said that in private the Saudis admitted that they had over-reacted. Mr. Moberly said that the latest signals from Jedda were more encouraging.
