1. FOLLOWING IS THE TEXT OF MR HURD'S STATEMENT TO THE SAUDI PRESS AGENCY AT JEDDA AIRPORT AT Ø63ØZ TODAY:-

BEGINS

I CAME HERE PERSONALLY TO UNDERLINE THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT'S REGRET AT THE UNDERSTANDABLE OFFENCE CAUSED BY THE SHOWING OF THE FILM ''DEATH OF A PRINCESS'', AND TO PROPOSE CERTAIN IDEAS AND PROCEDURES WHICH WOULD CONTRIBUTE TO THE RESTORATION OF MUTUAL UNDERSTANDING AND THE FUTURE DEVELOPMENT OF FRIENDLY RELATIONS. THESE WERE WELCOMED BY HRH PRINCE SAUD ON BEHALF OF THE SAUDI GOVERNMENT. AS A RESULT OF OUR DISCUSSIONS IT WAS AGREED THAT THE SAUDI GOVERNMENT WILL ARRANGE FOR THE EARLY ARRIVAL OF THEIR NEW AMBASSADOR IN LONDON AND THAT MR CRAIG WILL RETURN TO JEDDA. THIS DECISION DEMONSTRATES THE AGREEMENT OF BOTH GOVERNMENTS TO CONDUCT ALL ASPECTS OF THEIR RELATIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TRADITIONAL FRIENDSHIP BETWEEN THEM.

HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS SAID THAT HE WOULD WELCOME A VISIT BY LORD CARRINGTON TO THE KINGDOM OF SAUDI ARABIA IN ORDER TO DISCUSS THE MANY INTERNATIONAL PROBLEMS IN WHICH THE TWO COUNTRIES HAVE A COMMON INTEREST AND ON WHICH THEY WITH TO WORK TOGETHER. IT HAS BEEN AGREED THAT THE VISIT SHOULD TAKE PLACE ON 26 AUGUST.

1. THE FOLLOWING IS TEXT OF STATEMENT MADE BY SAUDI MFA SPOKES-MAN TO SAUDI PRESS AGENCY AT JEDDA AIRPORT AT \$630Z TODAY.

BEGINS

HIS EXCELLENCY MR DOUGLAS HURD, MINISTER OF STATE IN THE BRITSH FOREIGN OFFICE VISITED THE KINGDOM OF SAUDI ARABIA ON SATURDAY AND SUNDAY 14 - 15 RAMADAN 1400 (26 - 27 JULY 1980) AND MET WITH HRH PRINCE SAUD AL FAISAL, MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS.

THE BRITISH MINSTER CONVEYED TO HIS HIGHNESS THE REGRET OF HIS
GOVERNMENT AT THE COOLNESS THAT HAD OCCUREED RECENTLY IN THE
RELATIONS BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES AND HIS HOPE THAT THESE
RELATIONS WOULD RETURN TO THEIR FORMER STATE OF MUTUAL FRIENDSHIP
AND COOPERATION. THE MINISTER PUT FORWARD TO HIS HIGHNESS SOME
IDEAS AND PROCEDURES WHICH COULD HELP TO DEVELOP THE UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN THE TWO PEOPLES AND TO INCREASE THE UNDERSTANDING
OF THE BRITISH PEOPLE FOR ISLAMIC VALUES AND TRADITIONS.

HRH PRINCE SAUD AL FAISAL EXPRESSED HIS SATISFACTION WITH THE PROPOSED IDEAS CONFIRMING TO HIS EXCELLENCY THE WISH OF HIS MAJESTY'S GOVERNMENT TO HAVE STRONG AND FIRM RELATIONS WITH BRITAIN ON THE BASIS OF MUTUAL RESPECT AND COMMON INTERESTS AND IN THE SPIRIT OF THE TRADITIONAL FRIENDSHIP WHICH LINKS THE TWO COUNTRIES. HIS HIGHNESS EXPRESSED THE APPRECIATION OF THE KINGDOM OF SAUDI ARABIA FOR THE POSITIVE EVOLUTION IN THE POSITION OF THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT TOWARDS THE MIDDLE EAST AND THE PALESTINE QUESTION. IT WAS THIS - TOGETHER WITH THE EFFECTIVE ROLE PLAYED BY BRITIAN ON THE INTERNATIONAL LEVEL GENERALLY AND ESPECIALLY WITHIN THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITY - THAT GAVE IMPORTANCE TO THE EXISTENCE OF STRONG TIES BETWEEN THE TWO GOVERNMENTS.
