MESSAGE FROM THE GOVERNMENT OF PERU TO THE GOVERNMENTS OF THE UNITED KINGDOM AND ARGENTINA AND TO THE ORGANISATION OF AMERICAN STATES (Translation) The Government of Peru, profoundly disturbed by the events taking place in the 'Malvinas Islands' and by the possibility of an imminent commencement of hostilities between the United Kingdom and the Republic of Argentina, proposes formally to both Governments that, in keeping with the first paragraph of the recent Resolution 502 of the UN Security Council, they establish a truce of 72 hours while there are taking place the good offices procedures accepted by the parties concerned, which the Government of the United States is conducting, in order to avoid an armed confrontation which would contribute to increasing the gravity of the situation with a serious threat to international peace and security. 11 April 1982
