1. IT IS CLEAR FROM WHAT DEPUTY FOREIGN MINISTER TELLO TOLD ME (MY TELNO 299) THAT MEXICO WOULD NOT IMPOSE SANCTIONS ON BRITAIN EVEN IF A TWO THIRDS MAJORITY WERE TO VOTE FOR SUCH SANCTIONS. 2.
