I must add my voice of protest at the way the BBC is presenting the Falklands news. So many constituents were outraged by the Panorama programme that I took the trouble to see the video today. Frankly it was disgraceful. A disproportionate amount of time was given to the Argentine Minister being interviewed by a most obsequious man who could not have been more reverent had he been questioning the Pope ! More acres of space were accorded to eccentric minority opinion on both sides of the House. By no stretch of imagination can Anthony Meyer or David Crouch be described as representing Conservative Parliamentary opinion - on this issue or any other.

The whole impression given was of a pigheaded Prime Minister and Party Chairman flying in the face of opinion on all sides. I can only describe this as preposterous.
