2. EAGLEBURGER AND STOESSEL WERE AS ANXIOUS AS WE ARE TO AVOID GETTING BACK INTO THE SECURITY COUNCIL BUT THOUGHT THAT THE PANAMANIAN, AMONG OTHERS, WOULD MAKE MISCHIEF. EAGLEBURGER SAID THAT IF THE WRONG RESOLUTION WERE TO BE PUT FORWARD IN THE COUNCIL BRITAIN WOULD NO DOUBT VETO AND HE ASSUMED THAT THE US WOULD DO LIKewise. HE ASKED WHETHER WE WERE WORKING ON THE FRENCH TO KEEP THEM ON OUR SIDE, WITH THE IMPLICATION THAT IT WOULD HELP THE US TO VETO IF THE FRENCH WERE ALSO ON BOARD.
