Better if John Nott handles events from PR point of view for the moment. I think PM should be quiet with media this weekend pending clarification, success and news of casualties. Tomorrow may be a better time for her to say something; but I am inclined to think we should wait until Monday before she makes herself available for radio or television. But so far so good. I shall be around at home all the time except when at the hospital. I will be in the office Sunday afternoon from 1530 (Lobby briefing at 1700 and Americans at 1800). 22 May 1982
