We have no wish to add to the tragic loss of life which both Britain and Argentina have already suffered in this conflict. If any means could be found to persuade the Argentine Government to withdraw their forces, as demanded by the United Nations Security Council as far back as 3 April, further conflict could be avoided.

Despite Argentina's persistent refusal over more than nine weeks to comply with this Resolution, I still hope that it may not be too late for them to agree to take this step and to end their aggression.
