RECORD OF A CONVERSATION BETWEEN THE PRIME MINISTER AND
PRESIDENT BURNHAM OF GUYANA ON TUESDAY 15 JUNE 1982 AT 2215

PM: Forbes, how are you?

Mr. Burnham: I am fine. I just rang to say congratulations and best of luck.

PM: How marvellous of you to ring. Particularly, with all the things you have to worry about now.

Mr. Burnham: Oh well, never too much to worry about a friend.

PM: Well, that's marvellous of you. You've been absolutely wonderful about it and it's such a comfort to know we've a real friend in the Security Council.

Mr. Burnham: Good, I'm glad you think so. You'll be hearing from me.

PM: All right Forbes. But you yourself are well.

Mr. Burnham: Oh yes, thanks.

PM: And the protocol runs out soon, doesn't it, in a few days.

Mr. Burnham: We'll keep our fingers crossed.

PM: Yes, keep our fingers crossed. I just hope that what we've done already is a little bit of a warning.

Mr. Burnham: I would have put it as a lesson.

PM: A lesson, that's right. Well if the good we've done can extend beyond the Falklands that's just exactly what we wanted

Mr. Burnham: Thank you so much.

PM: Forbes, it's really wonderful of you to ring. Much appreciated.

Mr. Burnham: Not at all Margaret.
