The Falklands: Commonwealth Heads of Government Regional Meeting

Thank you for your letters of 4 and 8 October.

The Prime Minister agrees to send a message to the Prime Minister of Fiji. The text would be as in the first draft telegram annexed to your letter of 4 October, subject to the following amendments:

(a) Page 1, line 13

Delete "goodwill and".

(b) Page 1, line 25

Substitute "should" for "would".

(c) Page 2, line 14

After "invade" add a new sentence reading "Our losses were considerable, despite our success.".

Then delete in lines 15-17 all from "and for the British people" to "of the Falkland Islands", so that the next sentence begins "They now have to live with"

(d) Page 3, line 10

Substitute "should" for "could".

(e) Add the wording in your letter of 8 October.
