LORD KING'S MEETING WITH THE PRIME MINISTER -THURSDAY 27TH SEPTEMBER

Cecil Parkinson asked me to relay the following message to the Prime Minister, having spoken himself, privately, to Lord King:-

- Lord King is coming in as a supporter of the Prime Minister and sorry about any embarrassment he might have caused over stories in the press about his resignation.
- Cecil Parkinson told him that he could not possibly expect the Cabinet to sacrifice Nicholas Ridley.
- 3. Lord King is therefore in a constructive frame of mind, prepared to make an offer which is broadly: for BA to give up its Saudi Arabia operation and to take over from BCal loss-making operations which BA believes it can turn round into profit. Apparently the net profit transfer from BA would be £17-£20 million.

For obvious reasons Cecil Parkinson would not want the Prime Minister to let Lord King know that he has spoken to me about this.
