## Embargo on Argentine Imports

- 1. Thank you for sending me a copy of your letter of 11 June to Michael Jopling about our embargo on imports from Argentina.
- 2. You will meanwhile have seen the Attorney General's advice, confirming that it is now difficult to justify the ban under Article 224 of the Treaty of Rome. I agree that we should meet soon to consider the future of the embargo with Michael Jopling and Barney Hayhoe, on the lines I suggested in my minute of 12 March. I look forward to receiving the paper your officials are preparing to help our discussion.
- 3. I am copying this minute to the Prime Minister, the Minister of Agriculture, Minister of State at the Treasury and Sir Robert Armstrong.
