LIEUTENANT SETHIA: PRODUCTION OF DIARY

As David Norgrove told Denis Brennan, the Prime Minister agrees that, subject to the Law Officers' agreement, the Treasury Solicitor should stand ready to take steps to prevent disclosure of passages in Lieutenant Sethia's diary on the grounds of public interest immunity.
