> I should like, however, to let you know that in the opinion of Lord Barber - for whose judgement both the Prime Minister and I have much respect - both the tenor and substance of your government's response to the Group this week is likely to have a significant influence on the future course of the Group's mission. I am sure that you will agree that it is very much in the interests of both our Governments that the Group should be encouraged to try to develop their mission in a constructive way and not rush into making a hasty and negative report which would have very unfortunate international repercussions. We very much hope therefore, that South African Ministers will feel able to reply to the Group in terms which leave open the possibility of further movement on their proposals and encourage them to For my Government's part, we shally be prepared to encourage maximum flexibility on the part of all others concerned and to stress to them the crucial importance of a suspension of violence as part of any future understanding.
