MY TELNO 536: FALKLAND ISLAND FISHERIES

- 1. AN OFFICIAL FROM THE ARGENTINE EMBASSY COMMERCIAL SECTION (WYDLER) CONFIRMED AT A MEETING OF MOSCOW AGRICULTURAL ATTACHES ON 19 MAY THAT SOVIET-ARGENTINE FIGHERIES TALKS HAVE BEEN BROKEN OFF. AN ARGENTIME DELEGATION LED BY JAIMES (UNDER SECRETARY FILSHERIES) AND MARCELO DEL PECH (UNDER SECRETARY MFA) VISITED MOSCOW FROM 4-9 MAY BUT FAILED TO REACH AN AGREEMENT WITH THE SOVIETS.
- 2. WYDLER COMMENTED THAT THE TWO SIDES HAD BEEN SPEAKING MUTUALLY LINCOMPREHENSIBLE LANGUAGES. THE ARGENTINES WERE ANXIOUS TO SECURE AN AGREEMENT THAT WOULD ESTABLISH FIXED FISHING ZONES. HACLUDING THE WATERS AROUND THE FALKLAND ISLANDS. THEY ALSO WANTED TO NEGOTIFATE PORT FACILITIES FOR SOVIET VESSELS IN ARGENTANE HARBOURS. THE SOVIETS. ON THE OTHER HAND, WERE INTERESTED ONLY IN SECURING THE HIGHEST POSSIBLE FISH CATCH QUOTAS. THEY HAD SHOWN NO LINTEREST IN PORT FACILIATIES OTHER THAN FOR EMERGENCY REPAIRS, AND HAD BEEN UNWILLING TO ENTER JUNTO NEGOTIFATIONS CONCERNING DISPUTED WATERS.
- 3. WYDLER SAND HE FORSAW LINTTLE LINKELIHOOD OF A SUCCESSFUL BILATERAL FISHERIES AGREEMENT BEING CONCLUDED. HE ATTRIBUTED THE SOVIETS' RELUCTANCE TO NEGOTIFATE AND THE SUBSEQUENT FAILURE OF THE TALKS TO BRITISH DIPLOMATING PRESSURE ON THE SOVIET UNION.
- 4. THE PRESENCE OF THE ARGENTINE NEGOTILATING TEAM IN MOSCOW ACCOUNTS FOR KOMPLEKTOV'S UNWILL-INGNESS TO GIVE ME ANY REASSURANCES ON 5 MAY.
