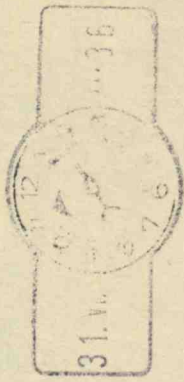
Please let him know that we appreciated the manner in which he pressed for the breakthrough we have all sought.
