MIPT: CHIEF BUTHELEZI'S SPEECH.

NEGOTIATIONS.

1. I SAT NEXT TO BUTHELEZI RT THE DINNEW. WE TALGED FOR A WHILE ABOUT CURRENT POLITICAL PROSPECTS.

2. I REMINDED HIM THAT AT OUR LAST MEETING HE HAD JUST GIVEN A QUALIFIED WELCOME FOR PRESIDENT BOTHA'S 12 JANUARY SPEECH IN CAPE TOWN. NOW DID HE FEEL ABOUT THE PROSPECTS NOW?: £3 '-80 5£-5 £3 2AS QUITE CONFUSED ABOUT THE PROSPECTS WHICH THE GOVERNMENT WERE OFFERING. THERE HAD BEEN NO MENTION BY BOTHA OF A STATUTORY COUNCIL: ON THE OTHER HAND A "COUNCIL OF STATE" WAS NOW BEING PUT FORWARD. HE FOUND IT DIFFICULT TO DISCERN WHAT SHAPE THE GOVERNMENT'S PROPOSALS WERE TAKING.

3. HE TOLD ME IN STRICT CONFIDENCE THAT HE HAD RECENTLY HAD A TWO HOUR MEETING WITH THE SA MINISTER OF JUSTICE, MR KOBIE COETZEE, AND HAD BEEN VERY IMPRESSED BY HIM.

4. HE HAD PUT TO THE MINISTER, AND ALSO MENTIONED TO ME, HIS IDEAS THAT THE GOVERNMENT SHOULD MAKE A DISTINCTION BETWEEN NELSON MANDELA AND HIS FELLOW POLITICAL PRISONERS ON THE ONE HAND, ABD THE ANC AS AN ORGANIZATION ON THE OTHERM HE HAD URGED COETZEE THAT THE GOVERNMENT SHOULD RELEASE MANDELA AND HIS FELLOW PRISONERS, BUT NOT UNBAN THE ANC IMMEDIATELY.

MANDELA AND HIS COLLEAGUES WOULD THEN HAVE TO WORK TOWARDS THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE ANC AS A POLITICAL ORGANIZATIO! BY THE COUNTRY AT LARGE, SUITABLE TO TAKE PART IN FURTHER CONSTITUTIONAL

5.TOSCAR DHLOMO: SECRETARY GENERAL OF INKATHA, WHO ALSO ATTENDED, EXPRESSED GUARDED OPTIMISM ABOUR PROGRESS IN THE KZAZULU/NATAL 8.0-BA. HE SAID THAT THE FARTICIPANTS WERE COMING UP TO THE POINT AT WHICH THEY WOULD HAVE TO DECIDE WHEBHER GROUP OR INDIVIDUAL RIGHTS SHOULD BE TAKEN AS THE BASIS FOR FURTHER CONSTITUTIONAL ARRANGEMENTS.
