SCOTTISH BLOCK Thank you for your letter of March outlining your suggestion that public expenditure on my programme is higher per head than that on equivalent English programmes and proposing a way of changing the way my public expenditure total is determined. I was surprised at the figure you quote in your letter for the extent to which my public expenditure provision exceeds your assessment of Scottish needs; and if it is decided to take the study further, I would want my officials to have an opportunity to see and comment on the detailed calculations which your officials have made. However, before we get to that stage, I think it would be helpful as you suggest for us to meet to go over the broader questions - especially those relating to the political consequences of any decision to change the way my public expenditure total is determined.
